School Meals

Starting from September 2024, there will be an increase in the price of our school meals. This increase is a necessary adjustment to cover current food and increased labour costs. We understand the financial concerns this may raise for some families and want to reassure you that this decision was made after careful consideration and has been limited to the minimum increase to cover rising costs.

The meal deal price will increase to £2.67 (main meal, pasta, sandwich or jacket plus a pudding or tray cake or water). We hope you agree that this is still excellent value for money when compared with other meal deals on the High Street. Our school meal service remains committed to providing nutritional menus, catering to various dietary preferences, while also ensuring value for money.

Uniform

Autumn Term

The academy re-opens for students next term on Wednesday 4th September 2024. There will be a phased return to school to accommodate various induction activities which are taking place, which gives us the opportunity to settle Year 7 into the school and accommodate some focussed work with Years 11, 12 and 13, before the rest of the school return. I would remind you that no students are allowed to leave the site at lunchtime.

Wednesday 4th September – Students in Years 7, 12 and 13 only return to school Thursday 5th September – Students in Year 11 return to school, along with Year 7, 12 and 13. Friday 6th September – All Year groups in school at normal time. Church Assembly will run as normal – all students should attend in full school uniform.
